






**Email**

- 1) You won't win anything on line. Cyber Criminals' favorite scams are Lottery prizes
- 2) Junk Mail; don't open unless sender is known
- 3) Don't use your name as an email address. Identity theft can start with knowing your name
- 4) Email addresses are personal. With a blanket email use BCC for addresses
- 5) Never open unknown received mail/attachments as a Virus/Trojan can be active, trolling your address book and hard drive and then passing itself on to them.




**Chat**

- 1) Log all chats.


Each "chat" program can record onto hard drive. Activate it.

- 2) Be aware of meeting Chatters. Use public places, take a friend or meet later at a designated time or call on a mobile phone (not text) regularly.
- 3) Habits of Chatter. If you don't understand a response or question; ask; they may be older then you think
- 4) Photographs. May not be up to date or be that person. See #2.
- 5) Webcams. Never put on a "floor show" as who is watching? Where will it end up?




**Fraud**

- 1) Bank emails. Never open. They will never email you; they use the Post Office
- 2) Ebay email. Latest offers after you used their service? Delete. Then go on Ebay and check out any offers.
- 3) PayPal email. See Ebay
- 4) Phone numbers. When they come in an email asking you to call; don't if you don't know them.
- 5) Inheritance Email. Delete! This will come in the US mail.
- 6) Microsoft Junk email. Delete. They never email unless you subscribe



**Passwords**

- 1) Never write them down
- 2) Use different on each website - major change
- 3) Change passwords each month
- 4) Never share passwords
- 5) Never email passwords
- 6) Ignore requests to share passwords. No one needs to know this info; not even the company web site you use; only their computers do.
- 7) In addition to passwords, never e-mail credit card numbers or account numbers.



**Questionable Websites**

- 1) All websites are lockable. Responsible parents should take this action on all computers (also email & chats)
- 2) Downloading a new program from internet? Save it rather than Run. This way, Spyware can scan and remove problems.
- 3) Perform regular virus and spyware scans and up-dates.
